#### **ELECTRONIC NOTICING FOR PRO SE PARTIES**

By registering for electronic notification, you will be **waiving** your right to receive service of documents by first class mail, according to Federal Rule Civil Procedure 5(b)(2)(E). Instead, you will be sent notices of electronic filing (NEF) via e-mail. In your e-mail mailbox, the notice will come from newd ecf@newd.uscourts.gov and the subject will be Activity in Case [xx]-cv-[xxx].

Upon receipt of the notice to your email inbox, you will be allowed **one** free look at the document by clicking on the document number. You should immediately **print or save the document for your records** to avoid future charges. **Your one free look will expire in 15 days from the date the notice was sent.** After the free look is used or expired, the document can be accessed by you through PACER (Public Access to Court Electronic Records); however, you may be charged to view the document. It is recommended that you establish a PACER account by visiting the PACER website at <a href="www.pacer.gov">www.pacer.gov</a>, so that you can view, print, and download documents at 24 hours a day for a nominal fee.

Because you will be receiving court-issued documents <u>only</u> in electronic form, you must maintain a valid e-email address and regularly check your e-mail.

Electronic service does <u>not</u> allow you to file documents electronically. You must continue to file all documents regarding your case in paper with the Court, either in-person or by mail.

## To be eligible you must:

- 1. Have one or more cases pending in the Western District of North Carolina;
- 2. Have a valid e-mail address;
- 3. Not be currently incarcerated;
- 4. Have regular access to a computer; and
- 5. Have a case that has been assigned a judge.

If you are eligible and wish to receive electronic notification of court issued documents and understand and agree to the information contained above, complete the attached registration form for each case you are requesting to receive electronic notification for and return the form(s) to the Court as noted.

#### Note: Electronic notification is NOT eligible for the following:

- Immigration cases
- Social Security cases
- Sealed cases
